1. To explain the Adlerian construct of lifestyle and how the BASIS-A can be used to assess it
2. To demonstrate giving strengths-based feedback using the BASIS-A Inventory
3. To discuss the impact of strengths-based language on a client's courage to be imperfect
4. To critique the usefulness of the BASIS-A in relation to other lifestyle assessments
5. To explain how to administer and score the BASIS-A with clients

This workshop is for child and youth counsellors, psychotherapists, marriage and family therapists, social workers, counsellors, psychologists, students, and anyone interested in increasing their counselling intervention skills as well as the Adlerian Psychology of Alfred Adler.
