Seven Counselling-Related Metaphors: Relationship Implications

Recognizing and responding to client spoken metaphors are two valuable counseling skills. The workshop will identify and illustrate seven specific types of metaphors that can be used in describing clinical scenarios. Following a theory input a demonstration with a volunteer will also be conducted. Audience discussion and clinical applications of metaphors will conclude the workshop.

A particular focus in the workshop will be using metaphors in relationships. Dr. Eckstein will also present four ways he assesses couples as part of his metaphors workshop.



Daniel Eckstein, Ph.D. is a visiting professor, Adler Graduate Professional School, Toronto. He is also a consulting psychologist for the Government on the Caribbean island of Saba.

Dr. Eckstein is author of eleven books, including *The Couples Match Book: Activities for lighting, rekindling, or extinguishing the Flame*, *Leadership by Encouragement*, and *Psychological Fingerprints*.

He has a Diplomate in Adlerian Studies and is a former president of the North American Society of Adlerian Psychology.
